

Kit List

Please ensure that the child is present when the bag is packed so they can locate all items on the list below.

**Uniform – Campaigner sweatshirt, Grey trousers (boys),
Navy/Grey skirts (girls), black/brown shoes.**

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- Cake (Junos, Inters & Craftsmen on 10+ camp)
- Health certificate & consent forms (handed in before camp)
- Bible (needs to include Old Testament)
- Sleeping bag (blankets and pillow?)
- Groundsheet (stout plastic will do)
- Night wear (include jumper and socks)
- Plate (high-sided is good), bowl, and mug (non-breakable)
- Knife, fork, dessert spoon, teaspoon (clearly marked)
- Bag for cutlery and plates etc.
- Tea towel
- Flannel, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste & toiletry bag
- Hand towel
- Comb/ hairbrush (and shampoo?)
- Waterproof coat
- Trainers
- Waterproof boots or wellington's
- Extra pairs of socks
- Changes of underwear (sanitary towels?)
- Pullovers
- Casual wear
- Swimming gear & towel
- Handkerchiefs / tissues
- Shoe cleaning kit?
- Note paper & pen/pencil
- Torch and batteries
- Sunhat and sun cream
- Plastic bags for dirty/wet clothes

Please note: Flat shoes or low-heeled shoes are needed for camp. Medium or high heels are most unsuitable.

Possible extras: Spending money, camera, camping mat or lilo, string for a clothes' line, and pegs.

Additional Information for Craftsmen/Leaders

An alarm clock or system is needed for camp.

Travel

We will be able to collect any Craftsmen who are not on Camp Aperitif at the same time as the Junos & Inters. The Rear Party will be given 'return home' arrangements separately.

Bulky items

Craftsmen should not bring bulky items such as tents and chairs without prior approval. Craftsmen are permitted to bring their own tent - subject to approval over the size/nature of the tent. Please check that your tent is complete, reasonably weather-proof, and that you know how to put it up. This might all seem obvious, but we write from experience of failures on each of those three issues.

The use of chairs will not be permitted in the meeting tent (too little space) except for medical issues, although a limited number of stools will be available for those unable to sit on the floor.

Camp Aperitif

Activities include boating & horse riding. You may want to consider appropriate footwear for those.

Travel is either at 9 a.m. on Tuesday 23rd July or after school time at about 4 p.m. on the same day. In both cases the meeting place is outside 24 Lambarde Road.

Travel on 23rd July is not in uniform, but make sure that you have smart uniform packed.

KEEP SAFE

Don't run close to tents.
Avoid walking around tent pegs & guy lines.
Don't go beyond the camp boundary without permission.
Keep away from farm animals and farm equipment.
Do not enter the cook or store tents without permission.
Use your sunhat/suncream on bright days



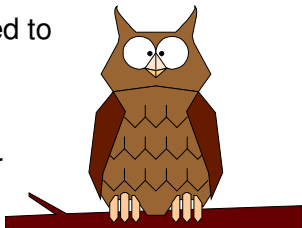
STAY HEALTHY

When you use the toilets remember to C.W.Z.
CLOSE the lid
WIPE your hands
ZIP up the tent when you leave

Keep wet items of clothing or bedding away from dry ones.
Air your tent and sleeping bag whenever you can.
Wash your hands before eating, or handling food.
Keep your tea towel off the ground.
Wash thoroughly and clean your teeth at least once a day.
Do not walk on groundsheets with your shoes on.

TIPS FROM THE WISE OLD OWL

Food plates that are deep as opposed to flat avoid spills.
Labelling your plates & cutlery really does help.
Your groundsheet needs to be larger than your sleeping bag.



General Information

Before camp

- Hand in your health certificate & consent forms
- Check that you have the correct uniform (see kit list). We are on show to the public on Sunday.
- You might want to check that all your gear is marked in some way

Cake

10+ campers are asked to provide a cake with 7 good servings. Please don't provide cakes with fresh cream as we do not have the facilities to refrigerate.

Money

All activities during camp are included in the camp fee. You will only require money for visits to the tuckshop and any shopping - if the occasion arises (quite unlikely).

Leave the technology at home!

Please note that we cannot guarantee the security or safety of electronic equipment under camp conditions. Any equipment that is brought by Junos, Inters or Craftsmen (including mobile phones) is at your own risk. Our experience is that the use of such devices spoils the camp experience, so they must be kept in the off condition and not seen or heard unless permission is given by a leader.
Remember that photographs are for your own private use.

At camp

Campers are not permitted to enter sleeping tents other than their own unless a leader gives them permission to do so.

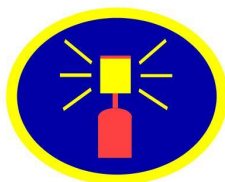
