Typical Kit List for Summer Camp

Uniform - includes grey trousers/navy skirt and shiny shoes.

Medical certificate (handed in before camp)

Sleeping bag (or blankets)

Groundsheet or stout plastic sheet

Night wear (include jumper & socks?)

Two plates (1 large, 1 deep – non-breakable)

Knife, fork, teaspoon, dessert spoon (labelled)

Mug

Flannel, soap, toothbrush, paste

Hand towel

Comb & shampoo

Change of underclothes (sanitary towels?)

Waterproof coat

Trainers or plimsolls

Wellingtons

Extra pairs of socks

Handkerchiefs

Pullover

Casual wear

Swimming gear

Teacloth

Note paper and writing gear

Bible

Torch and batteries

Sunhat and high factor suncream

Plastic bags for dirty/wet clothes
